



## **UK IDDSI IMPLEMENTATION CHECKLIST**

This is meant as guidance only! You may not have to follow all the steps in the same order – this is just a suggestion.

1.	ACTIONS (Smart objectives: By the end of the implementation period the objectives are to:)  Familiarise yourselves with IDDSI and ensure access to IDDSI website from the workplace. 2.	Set up a multi professional IDDSI Implementation Group in each locality.	Suggested professionals: Speech and Language Therapists, Dietitians, Nurses, pharmacists, caterers, manufacturers, representatives from: community and hospital, adult centre sector, schools, and domiciliary care providers. In England CCG involvement is suggested e.g. – Medicines management team.	Check that the implementation group is multiprofessional and contains all local stakeholders
3.	Notify the senior management in your local area that this implementation project will be commencing and the timeframe involved. They will need assurances that patient safety will be ensured.	Executive support is essential.	Executive support is confirmed and protected time for training allowed for all relevant staff
4.	Develop an implementation plan and a timeline/timeframe – talk to local suppliers and manufacturers to agree the timing of the implementation	Consider the option of implementing in 2 phases i.e. fluids first and then foods later.  Set objectives so that you can evaluate the success afterwards	A plan is agreed by all relevant stakeholders
