During this period of supervised practice, members must complete the RCSLT competence framework for overseas qualified practitioners. It will also support you with your continuing professional development (CPD) by providing you with a structure and the opportunity to reflect on your learning. You can use the RCSLT CPD diary to record your CPD and your progress through the competence framework. The competence framework must be signed off by a Certified RCSLT member and a Certified member of the overseas professional association.

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
