<p>Support from RCSLT Wales:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Reinstate 'Giving Voice'</li> <li>Template letters for MS</li> <li>Awareness days (across clinical specialisms)</li> <li>More communication about new resources, eg. Schools presentation</li> <li>Update about Basecamp – Professional Networks</li> <li>Supporting all clinical areas (even those not mentioned in the report, aware can't fit in everything)</li> </ul>
