What does your job involve?

Children's speech and language therapy in mainstream schools, pre-school settings, special school (SLD/PMLD), primary MLD units and ASD units

When did you start your job, and how did you find it?

I started my job in January 2017, I handed my CV in to my local team and, following an interview, started working in a band 5 bank post.

How did you prepare for interviews?

I contacted friends and previous colleagues from clinical placements to discuss potential questions and case scenarios. I also found it very useful to make scatter charts to think about my previous experiences and how these could be applied to the questions advised in online forums

What does your typical day look like?

I work across a range of different settings, making most clinical contact in schools and pre-schools during school hours. Following this I complete clinical notes, therapy plans, phone calls and other admin tasks

Do you have supervision support as an NQP and are you currently working through your competency framework? During the completion of my competencies, I had regular meetings with my mentor to discuss complex cases and ways of working. Following this, I have access to a regular supervision group and specialist 1:1s to support my working and development.

My advice to students:

Enjoy the experience and don't be worried or anxious if you feel lost at the start- it's totally normal and you'll be surprised how quickly everything will fall into place!

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
