### **Professor Marion Walker MBE**

Marion Walker MBE is Professor in Stroke Rehabilitation and Emeritus NIHR Senior Investigator at the University of Nottingham

Marion has a strong research portfolio covering a wide area of local, national and international research projects. She has particular expertise in the development and evaluation of complex interventions and has published widely on moving evidence from randomised controlled trials into routine clinical care. Marion is a strong advocate of patient partnership and has co-chaired the Nottingham Stroke Research Partnership Group for 10 years. She is a trustee of the Stroke Association and is passionate about supporting women in STEM subjects.

Marion is an NIHR Senior Investigator and was awarded an MBE in the Queen's New Year Honours list 2012 for her service to stroke rehabilitation and stroke survivors. She is an international advisor for stroke rehabilitation research in Sweden, Norway, India and Australia and holds honorary professorial positions at the University of Gothenburg and the University of Queensland.
